# **Coldwater Fall Fair Ambassador Program Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Q: Who is eligible to compete in the Coldwater Fall Fair Ambassador Contest?

A: Young women and men between the ages of 17 and 24 by August of 2018. (Must be 18 by August 2018)

# Q: What would be my duties as an Ambassador of the Coldwater Fall Fair?

A: Duties at the Fair – some public speaking, handing out ribbons, talking with the general public.

## Q: What would be my duties throughout the 2018/2019 year?

A: Some of the other events you attend will be: District Meeting (end of October) – You will meet all of the other Ambassadors in our Region. In February, a three-day convention in Toronto to prepare for the C.N.E. and learning new life skills. Attend the C.N.E. (opening weekend in August) – You will represent the Coldwater Fall Fair in the C.N.E. Ambassador Competition held the first three days of the C.N.E. with the chance of becoming the C.N.E. Ambassador (August 2018). Other events held throughout the year to attend include the Santa Claus Parade (December), Coldwater Lions Club Duck Race (May), Canada Day, Steampunk (August), etc.

# Q: What is the Coldwater Fall Fair looking for in a contestant?

A: We are looking for someone to best represent our Fair and our community. The successful candidates must possess the following qualities: • A people person. • Good public speaking skills. • Outgoing and energetic. • Knowledge about Agriculture & the history of our Fair

#### Q: Where and when will the contest be held?

A: On Wednesday, September 24th, 2018, above the Coldwater Arena.

#### Q: What should I wear?

A: Wear clothing appropriate for a job interview.

# Q: What sort of questions might I be asked during the contest?

A: You may be asked; general Fair or Agricultural questions, what you like most about the Fair, about issues in the community or province, about your hobbies/ interests/community involvement/goals, or about general farm questions (don't worry if you are not from a rural background).
