

Coldwater Fall Fair Ambassador Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who is eligible to compete in the Coldwater Fall Fair Senior Ambassador Program?

A: Young women and men between the ages of 17 and 24 by August of 2022. (Must be 18 by August 2023) can apply for the Senior Ambassador position.

Q: Who is eligible to compete in the Coldwater Fall Fair Junior Ambassador Program?

A: Young women and men between the ages of 12 to 15 can apply for the Junior Ambassador position.

Q: What would be my duties as an Ambassador of the Coldwater Fall Fair at the 2022 Coldwater Fall Fair weekend event?

A: Duties at the Fair – some public speaking, handing out ribbons, talking with the general public, sharing agricultural knowledge, supporting various areas of the Fair.

Q: What would be the Senior Ambassador duties throughout the 2022/2023 year?

A: Some of the other events you attend will be:

District Meeting (end of October) – You will meet all of the other Ambassadors in our Region.

In February, a three-day convention in Toronto to prepare for the C.N.E. and learning new life skills.

Attend the C.N.E. (opening weekend in August) – You will represent the Coldwater Fall Fair in the C.N.E.

Ambassador Competition held the first three days of the C.N.E. with the chance of becoming the C.N.E.

Ambassador (August 2023).

Other events held throughout the year to attend include the Santa Claus Parade (December), Coldwater Lions Club Duck Race (May), Canada Day, Steampunk (August), etc.

Q: What is the Coldwater Fall Fair looking for in a participant?

A: We are looking for someone to best represent our Fair and our community. The successful participant must possess the following qualities: • A people person. • Good public speaking skills. • Outgoing and energetic. • Knowledge about Agriculture & the history of our Fair

Q: Where and when will the contest be held?

A: On Sunday, September 18th, 2022, above the Coldwater Arena.

Q: What should I wear?

A: Wear clothing appropriate for a job interview, business casual.

Q: What sort of questions might I be asked during the Ambassador Program?

A: You may be asked; general Fair or Agricultural questions, what you like most about the Fair, about issues in the community or province, about your hobbies/ interests/community involvement/goals, or about general farm questions (don't worry if you are not from a rural background). Remember to just be yourself!

Q: What should I prepare for the Senior Ambassador Program?

A: Prepare a 3-5 minute speech, discussing your strengths, what you bring to the Coldwater Fall Fair board, share your knowledge of agriculture and the Coldwater Fall Fair, as well as include the theme of the current Fair year. Also, prepare a quick introduction to introduce yourself (name, age, quick interesting fact).
